Dear Mr. Ruiz:

Your request for information was received by the District on February 5, 2026, which included:

“Copies of all records reflecting the costs, expenditures, invoices, and payments for any Super Bowl-related event(s) hosted, organized, sponsored, or funded by the Office of the Superintendent and Superintendent Samuel Mijares of the Eagle Pass Independent School District for the past three fiscal years, including calendar years 2023, 2024, and 2025.

The records requested include, but are not limited to, budget summaries, accounting ledgers, credit card expenditures, purchase orders, invoices, receipts, vendor contracts, check registers, internal requisitions, reimbursement forms, audit reports, and any supporting documentation showing the total cost or expenses incurred by the district in connection with each Super Bowl event.

I also request any internal communications, meeting minutes, administrative approvals, or expense justification documentation related to the budgeting or spending for these Super Bowl event(s).”

We have determined that complying with your request will result in the imposition of a charge that exceeds \$40. We are therefore providing you notice of this anticipated cost as required by section 552.2615 of the Texas Government Code.

**Itemized Charges:**

Labor – 9 hours to locate and compile the requested information related to Super Bowl related event(s) @ \$15.00/Hr.	\$135.00
Overhead \$135.00 x .20	\$ 27.00
<b>Total Anticipated Charge</b>	<b>\$162.00</b>

There is a less expensive way for you to obtain this information. You may narrow or clarify your request. In addition, you may view any public documents in person at our offices. If you choose to view the information in person, we will need to find a mutually agreeable date and time for you to do so. However, please note that a modified cost estimate letter would be generated, but due to

the labor time needed to prepare the documents for your in-person viewing, the cost would likely remain substantially like the present approximation.

Please also note that submitting payment does not preclude the District from withholding some of the responsive information pending a decision by the Attorney General as to whether such information is subject to an exception to the Texas Public Information Act.

The anticipated charges exceed \$100.00; therefore, as allowed by section 552.263(a) of the Texas Government Code, we require a deposit of 100% (\$162.00) for payment of the anticipated costs.

Further, you may respond to this statement by delivering a written response to my attention by mail, in person, by facsimile transmission or by electronic mail. In your response, please state whether you will accept and agree to pay the anticipated charges, modify the request, or send to the Office of the Attorney General a complaint alleging that you have been overcharged.

Your request will be considered automatically withdrawn if you do not respond in writing to this statement, as set forth above, within 10 business days of the date of this letter that you either:

1. Accept the charges;
2. Wish to modify your request; OR
3. Have sent to the Open Records Division of the Office of the Attorney General a complaint alleging that you are being overcharged for the information you have requested.
